Newbury Recreation Summer Hiking and Camping Trip

Description: Two day hiking experience with an overnight camp-out in Fishersfield Park. We will do a 3-4 hour hike on day 1, then overnight at the park, followed by a Day 2 hike to Mt. Sunapee Resort where the camper can choose between mini-golf or Frisbee golf. The hike will begin on July 15th at 12pm at the Chalk Pond Tennis Courts and pick-up will be at 3pm on July 16th at the Mt. Sunapee ski area parking lot. All meals will be provided in the camp cost except for lunch on the 15th which each camper will pack with them. At least two experienced wilderness safety personnel will be with the group at all times and all staff have been background checked. This is year three of this camp, but a little toned down, the hiking distances are 3 miles less than last year. All tents will be separated by gender and age appropriateness.
